RECENT GRADUATE SUCCESSES

Patricia — "I lost my job and I was so desperately looking for a job to cover my needs, a friend give me the information of crossroad, so I called and left a message. The next early morning Yanci called me and explained how I could be part of the Crossroads program. Since the first appointment, crossroad made me feel so comfortable. They worked on my resume and cover letter, sent me several emails for interviews with prospective employers. As a mom I always dreamed of working for the county during the hours that work with my family. I applied and interviewed at different places including LCPS. After 3 weeks I got a call from LCPS with a job offer!"

Natalia moved to the US from El Salvador two years ago with a nursing degree, but little English. She attended and graduated from Loudoun County high school. She then came to **CJ**. Her job counselor helped create a resume and prepare her for job interviews. She submitted her resume to several medical facilities and senior care centers. Soon after, she received



phone calls for two interviews on the same day. She received job offers from both places. She was extremely excited and accepted the position at a local healthcare center, a place that provides excellent opportunities towards her future goals.

Laura came to CJ feeling discouraged, having applied to many positions in her field with few interviews. CJ encouraged her to apply for a few specific openings then emailed HR managers. She spent two hours the day before the interview, practicing standard interviewing questions, focusing on her skills and how they fit the job. Two weeks later, she found out she was hired!



Guillermo needed a part time evening position to adequately support his family. A local office cleaning company sent a job description that fit the hours needed. **CJ** arranged an interview and he received a job offer and now earns enough to support his family.
