Local employers are hiring, so we continue to provide job seekers with the tools and assistance they need to land an interview, and employers with pre-screened applicants. Regardless of how much technology is available and required in 2022, the hiring process almost always requires that face-to-face interview between applicant and employer. Since we *get to know the person, not just the resume*, we are able to ease the way!

We are so incredibly grateful to everyone who gave generously during the 24-hour GiveChoose campaign on March 29th, sponsored by The Community Foundation for Loudoun and Northern Fauquier Counties. 2022 MISSION UPDATE - WE MOVED!

We moved to a new location in Leesburg! After 9 ½ years on East Market Street, we decided to move to office space owned by Loudoun Cares, and we LOVE IT! Our new address is: 8C South Street, SW, Leesburg, VA 20175. Please visit us!!

To date in 2022, we have:

- Interviewed 56 new applicants with:
 - 98% qualifying as extremely low to moderate income for Loudoun County
 - o 93% meet the criteria for extremely lowincome which means their income is 0-30% of the area median gross income
 - o 34% unhoused or precariously housed
 - 25% female heads of household
 - o 13% victims of domestic abuse
- 22 permanent placements with several job interviews in the works, so stay tuned!
- 81 Job openings shared by local employers, many with multiple openings
- 65 application processes completed, including online applications/resumes submitted, and interviews arranged

UPDATE ON JOB COACHING

In January 2020, we hired a retired special education teacher, Betsy Coffey-Chaudet, to launch our Job Coaching program, designed to supplement the existing post-placement support by providing in-person job coaching to individuals with disabilities.

Betsy carried us through the pandemic by job coaching several placed applicants, ensuring job success and retention. With the pandemic receding – hopefully for good – we are thrilled to announce that we have relaunched our job coaching program by hiring Allison Suliveras to assist Betsy as a dedicated Job Coach to provide on-site support to applicants with disabilities. Allison has already job coached several placed applicants. Welcome, Allison!


